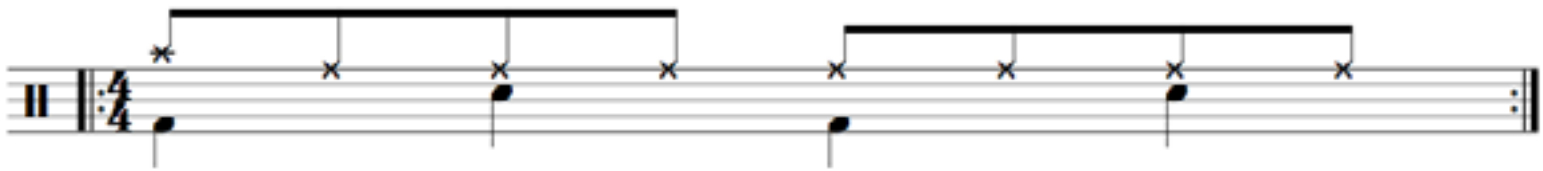


Weak Hand Crashing

All crash cymbals to be layed with your WEAK HAND (so, left hand, for right-handers, or right hand if you're left-handed.)

Start by just putting a crash on beat one, just like in a normal groove -



Now we're going to put that crash cymbal on beat four, instead. Still play the crash with your left hand (right hand, if you're left-handed), and move your right hand (or left hand) over from the ride cymbal to play the snare drum on that beat. Like this -



Combine those two grooves, and you end up playing the crashes on beats one AND four. Still play the crashes with your weak hand!



The last thing we're going to do is add in a note on the rack tom as your hand "travels" back from the snare drum (on beat four) to the ride cymbal. Like so -
